A very stylish chablis with lovely body and impeccable balance. Steely and refreshing.
- 6 Sauvignon Blanc, Marisco (New Zealand)** **£25**
Pure and vibrant. Classically Marlborough, this wine is bursting with zesty citrus and capsicum flavours tightly woven together by its juicy acidity.
